Now that summer is here and the weather is so wet we thought we would update you on the procedure for clubs in bad weather etc.

If a club is cancelled we will contact you to let you know as soon as possible. If you haven't heard you can assume the club is on. It is very important, therefore, that Sarah has contact details for you or the person who collects from clubs, so that we can arrange for the children to get home in the usual way. If they are not sure they could come along for a 'taster session' to see if they like it.
